The proceeds from the event were donated to Harvest Hope Food Bank for Thanksgiving.

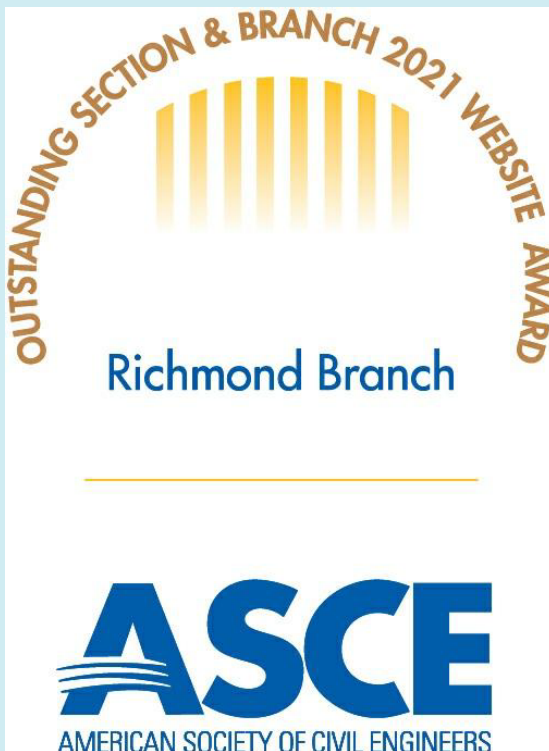


## Tennessee
