

#### **Region 8 Director's Corner**

Hello Region 8!

Greetings from Chicago!

I'm writing this column from my hotel room after attending a 2day Board of Direction meeting which precedes the annual



Society Convention, which starts on Thursday, October 19th and runs through Saturday the 21st. The BOD meeting had a packed agenda and included discussions on several topics of interest to ASCE members in Region 8, including an update on the start-up of the new Grants and Business Development Department at Headquarters.

The purpose of this new department is to centralize our

ability to seek out sole-source non-competitive grant opportunities from various federal government agencies and NGOs to fund new initiatives for ASCE to undertake in areas such as climate adaptation, standards development, and workforce development. The intent is to be able to fund these new initiatives from grant sources that would otherwise have to be funded out of our annual operating budget. The new department is just now being staffed up, but it is anticipated that it will significantly enhance our ability to leverage our standing within the federal government as trusted advisors and thought leaders in these and many other areas.

With the passage of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (the IIJA), ASCE has assumed a larger role in the development and retention of the civil engineering workforce. A recent study by the American Consulting Engineers Council (ACEC) determined that the impacts of the IIJA on the civil engineering workforce will be enormous. The ACEC study projects that there are presently at least 82,000 more jobs for engineers than there are engineers available to

fill those positions. Part of this glut of unfilled positions is due to retirements of baby boomers (like me!) who are leaving the workforce. This means two things: (1) it's a great time to be an engineer with the prospect of full employment and rising salaries, and (2) our colleges and universities urgently need to attract and graduate more engineering students to fill those vacant jobs. All of us have a responsibility to encourage middle school and high school students to seek an engineering education.

Finally, I just want to remind all of you that the December 1st deadline for filing an intent to run for Region 8 Governor or Director is rapidly approaching. I strongly encourage any of you who are interested in serving the profession to consider running for one of these positions. I guarantee that you will meet some folks you will otherwise never get to know and have some fun in the process. 
